## Directions for collection of domestic garbage and recyclables

- Place your bins beside the road the evening before collection day. Place them so that the handles face the road and move the bins back onto your property quickly following collection.
- Place domestic garbage in the black bins or in containers intended for this purpose. Boxes and garbage outside the bins will not be picked up.
- Place recyclable materials (and nothing else) in green bins or blue bags. If there is an excess amount, place recyclables in containers that are recyclable and easy to handle and place these beside the bin. Bins or bags containing non-recyclable materials will not be emptied.
- Remove all snow and ice from the top and sides of bins, boxes and garbage cans so that they are easily accessible. Bins and boxes covered with snow and difficult to access will not be emptied.

### Collection of large items

Only the following objects will be accepted during the collection of large items:

- old house and garden furniture (tables, chairs, desks, sofas, beds, mattresses)
- some household appliances (stoves, dishwashers, washers, dryers, water heaters).

You may dispose of your other large items at the **dry materials depots**:

Computers and electronic equipment (computers, TVs, microwave ovens, etc.)	Free
Mattresses and box springs	Free
Green waste (dead leaves, grass clippings)	Free (seasonal service)
Materials from construction, renovation and demolition (stone, concrete, ceramics, baths, showers, toilets, sinks, carpets, branches, wood)	Charges apply
Various materials (pool covers, play sets, barbecue, lawnmowers...)	Charges apply

### Refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners

The Recyc-Frigo program salvages old refrigerators and freezers **in working condition** (certain conditions apply: [www.recyc-frigo.com](http://www.recyc-frigo.com) or 1 877 493-7446) and gives you a cheque in return. Other electrical appliances which contain halocarbons or are not in working order must be taken to the dry materials depot located in Rivière-Rouge at 688 chemin du Parc industriel. Charges apply. The depot can be reached at 819-275-3205.



### Dangerous household waste

This depot accepts only residential waste and is open on the first and third Saturdays of each month, from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m. It is located behind the municipal garage (60 chemin de Brébeuf).

Paint, varnish, solvents, aerosols and batteries are some of the products accepted, Consult the Ville's website for further details, or contact us.



### I am recyclable

Paper and cardboard: Newspapers and magazines, paper and envelopes, cardboard boxes, milk and cream cartons

Plastic: All plastic containers and lids bearing numbers 1, 2, 4, 5, 7

Metal: Cans, pop-type cans, aluminum plates, hangers, pipes and pots/pans

Glass: All bottles and glass containers
